

# Low-Cost Spay and Neuter

Income Eligible Program through HSYC  
Eligibility Application

Please read application in full. Failing to do so causes confusion. Thank you for applying to have your dog or cat spayed or neutered through this program with **The Humane Society of Yates County**. The Goal is to provide low-cost spay and neuter services to qualified applicants. Surgically removing reproductive organs helps lower the number of stray and unwanted animals, among many other benefits.

**Please fill out the application completely and include proof of income\* with required documentation.** Incomplete applications will delay approval. Applications are reviewed on an ongoing basis. If there is a problem and we cannot reach you, the application goes on hold until resolved. *You will be contacted as soon as we can schedule your animal(s).*

\*Proof of income can be your most recent W2 form, 2 most recent paycheck stubs, or a statement of approval of benefits from any assistance program. (including but not limited to form SSA-1099)

We will certainly work with individuals on a case by case basis. We encourage our clients to save as far in advance as possible for the fee. The prices are greatly reduced thanks to a *grant* approved by the **ASPCA**.

### Important information:

1. Proof of rabies/distemper vaccinations is required if your pet has been previously vaccinated. Please bring your medical records with you the morning of check in. Not doing so may jeopardize your spot on the eligibility list.
2. The animal(s) cannot have anything to eat after 8pm the day before their appointment. (They may have water)
3. Check-in time is very important. On the day of the appointment check-in will be at 8:20a. Here at the SHELTER. No earlier than 8:20 and no later than 8:25a.
4. Cat(s) must come in a hard-sided cat carrier no more than one cat per carrier. No Cardboard or soft luggage type carriers. If you do not have a Hard-Sided Cat Carrier, Contact the HSYC's Spay/Neuter Line at 607.244.5893 to see about using one at least 48 hours prior to the appointment.
5. If you fail to pick up the animal by 12pm the day following surgery, there will be an added \$15 per hour fee.

\*\*\*The cost for Surgery of a male or female cat is \$25, but subject to change at anytime. Vaccination for Rabies is \$9 and Distemper is \$19, if the animal does not have proper documentation stating they already have them. Pricing for Dog spays and neuters are \$50. This price also being subject to change at anytime. Ear mite treatment is \$21.25 if needed. There are possible additional costs for each individual animal; Fleas, Hernia, Pregnancy, etc.,

8. If you fail to pick up the animal by 11am, there will be an added \$15 per hour fee.
